

How to get your Driver's License

You must first get a Driver's Manual from the Driver License Center

After you read and study the Driver's Manual, you must get a physical examination by your doctor with the Medical Qualification Certificate form

Visit the Driver's License Center

If you are under 18
You need to have: The completed DL-180, The completed DL-180 TD, Proof of Identity, Social Security Card, and a check or money order for the appropriate fee.

If you are over 18
You need to have: The completed DL-180, Proof of Identity, 2 Proofs of Residency, Social Security Card, and a check or money order for the appropriate fee

You must wait 6 months and have 50 hours of driving experience, before you can schedule your driving exam

If you are Under 18
You have now gotten your Learner's Permit!

You will be given an eye screening and a knowledge test, that you must pass

When it comes time to schedule your Driving Exam, you will need to bring your Valid Learners Permit, Parent/Guardian Certification form, Proof of Vehicle insurance and registration, and the accompanying driver's valid license

If you are Over 18
If you feel you are ready you can schedule your driving exam as soon as you want

If you Passed

If You Failed

You must take the permit test again

If you Failed
You must retake your Driver's test

You have gotten your Driver's License!
