


Carrie:


On this day things are starting off strange since, she got her period that day and come to find out this is her first period ever, at the age of 17.





Of course, Carrie's mother was less than accepting of her being taken out, she instructs Carrie to the closet and pray instead of going to the Prom.





Carrie responds with telekinetic push which frightening her mother.




